Windland Repower II, and Idaho LLC, and AAER Inc. have entered into a Turbine Supply Agreement for the delivery and Installation of two 1.5 Megawatt Wind Turbines. The turbines will be installed on 80 meter towers and will have a rotor diameter of 70 meters (Approximately 230 ft). The turbines are expected to produce enough electricity to power over 1,000 homes.

The turbines will be installed in the Tehachapi Mountains on Windland's existing wind farm in southern California.
