Today, CG Power Solutions USA Inc. has agreed to purchase Power County Wind Parks, LLC from Windland, Inc. The LLC contains 2 project companies, each with an executed PURPA contract with PacifiCorp. The total nameplate capacity between the two projects is expected to be between 43-45 MW. The projects are scheduled to come online by December 31, 2011.
